## English

- ENGL 1010 credit can also be earned by passing the AP Language or AP Literature exam with a score of 3-5. *(Students must take a copy of their AP score and \$25 cash/check to the DSU registrar to have the ENGL 1010 credit transcribed before they can register for ENGL 2010)*
- Placement into ENGL 2010 can occur without a CPT score if ENGL 1010 was completed with a "C" grade or better.

- Placement into PHYS 1010/15, when taught on the high school campus, can occur without a CPT score if a student successfully completes any high school or CE Biology or Chemistry course.

| MATH 1060     | Trigonometry                 | 3.0     | 25+                     | 52+        |
| MATH 1080     | Pre-Calculus w/Trigonometry  | 5.0     | 25+                     | 52+        |
| MATH 1210     | Calculus I                   | 4.0     | 26+                     | 76+        |

- You must have taken Secondary Mathematics 1, 2 & 3 to qualify to take any CE Math class.
- MATH 1010 does not meet college GE Math requirements for a degree, but rather, as a prerequisite for students with low CPT scores to qualify for MATH 1030, 1040, 1050, 1080, etc.
- Placement into MATH 1010, 1030 & 1040 can occur without a CPT score if Secondary Mathematics 1, 2 & 3 were completed with a “C” average in each.
- Placement into MATH 1050 can occur without a CPT score if MATH 1010 was completed with a “C” grade or better.
- Placement into MATH 1060 or MATH 1080 can occur without a CPT score if MATH 1050 was completed with a “C” grade or better.
- MATH 1060 is recommended to students who complete MATH 1050, while MATH 1080 is recommended for students who skip/test-out of MATH 1050.
- It is recommended that students do not “test-in” to MATH 1210, but rather qualify by taking MATH 1080 or by taking MATH 1050 & 1060.
- All college-level math classes taken after high school graduation, requires a qualifying CPT score.
