Spring 2019 – **DSU NORTH PLAZA BUILDING CE REGISTRATION INFORMATION**

Before reading any further, you must have completed your State DUS Concurrent Enrollment application. If you are not currently in a CE class this fall you'll need to do this—even if you have previously been admitted to DSU. The State CE application can be accessed from our web page www.concurrent.dixie.edu/admission/. Approximately 24-48 hours later, you should be able to access your Dixie ID# from the bottom of that same web page. If you think you may have applied in the past but did not actually register for courses, please call Sheila Cannon at 652-7739 and she can verify your status.

- Attached is your priority registration form for DSU Concurrent Enrollment classes at the North Plaza Building on the main campus. Priority registration gives you first priority status to CE North Plaza classes in the fall. Priority registration for classes at North Plaza Building began on Thursday, Nov. 15, 2018 and ends Friday, Dec 14th, 2018. *NOTE: If you are registered for a CE class on your high school's PowerSchool, this does not guarantee you placement into classes on the DSU campus.*
- This form is **NOT** for courses which will be taught for university credit on your high school campus. High school campus CE courses have their own registration form listed under your high school's name on <https://concurrent.dixie.edu/registration/>. Please remember that you will receive both university and high school credit for this registration, so again, make sure you have talked to your high school counselor. Also, remember that the two registrations are independent of each other. You must submit a registration form to the university to be placed in the university course.
- **Priority registration forms are due in the DSU Concurrent Enrollment Office between Thursday, Nov. 15 and Friday, Dec. 14, 2018. You may deliver the form to the Concurrent Enrollment Office, which is located at 46 South 1000 East in St. George, M-F, 8 am to 5 pm. Do NOT submit this form to your high school counselors. Registrations will be processed on a first-come, first-registered basis. Once the class size limit is met, registration will close for that class.**
- Partial tuition payments will be paid online through your MyDixie account. Your balances may not be visible until after Jan. 11, 2019 so you will not need to pay until after that date.
- Make sure that you attach a high school transcript (or had one sent) and any necessary placement test scores, to the registration form. Approximately one week after you submit your registration form, please check your MyDixie account for confirmation of your class registration. You may also check the receipt of any payments here. The link is located in the upper right hand corner of the DSU CE homepage – www.concurrent.dixie.edu. You will need your Dixie ID# and password to log in to your account. There is an option on the bottom of the page at <https://concurrent.dixie.edu/admission/> if you have forgot either.
